**MPS ENGAGES INTERPOL TO TRACE AND ARREST SODOMY SUSPECT
PARAMJIT SINGH**

The Malawi Police Service (MPS) informs Malawians that it has raised a red flag through INTERPOL to arrest Bakeline Limited Company former employee, Paramjit Singh, of Patiala, Chandigarh, India, as he is implicated in a sodomy case where the alleged victims are two other employees of the same company, and of Malawian origin.

Reports in police possession indicate that the suspect fled the country on January 28, 2022 through Kamuzu International Airport when he got wind of his impending arrest.

The MPS has already furnished INTERPOL with the details of the suspect believed to be in India. The service further assures Malawians and the victims that all procedures are being followed to arrest the suspect for prosecution.
